**Maghreb-American Health Foundation announces  
medical mission to Algeria**

Philadelphia, PA (April 1st, 2016) - The ***Maghreb-American Health Foundation*** has announced the upcoming medical mission to Médéa (Algeria) later in the month of April 2016.

The goals of this first mission to the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria is to (i) introduce the ***Maghreb-American Health Foundation*** and establish a strong partnership with health officials and local organizations in Algeria, (ii) treat young patients suffering from Spina Bifida, and (iii) organize workshops and learning events by US doctors with Algeria doctors.

The ***Maghreb-American Health Foundation*** will lead a team composed of 17 American volunteer medical professionals, specialized in neurosurgery, cardiology, and anesthesia who will work jointly with local medical teams to provide medical treatment to children age 0 to 14 years old suffering from Spina Bifida.

This mission will take place at the Mohamed Boudiaf Hospital in Médéa, Algeria from April 23 through 29, 2016.
